TERMS & CONDITIONS

Please ensure you have read these conditions carefully in advance of the competition.

Conditions of entry

- The Judges' decision is final.
- The Centre reserves the right to change any published judges, but will endeavour to inform all pre-entered affected exhibitors prior to show day.
- Where sufficient entries are forward, classes will be split by breed, age or height as appropriate.
- The Centre reserves the right to cancel or amalgamate classes in the event of insufficient entries.
- Classes will be judged guided by the rules for that section's appropriate affiliated Society (ie The Veteran Horse Society, British Show Horse Association, Ponies (UK) etc). Copies of rule books will be available at the Secretary's desk for competitors to avail themselves of if required
- An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a pony bred, sold, leased, produced, broken or trained by the judge.
- A rider/handler may not compete in a class judged by someone for whom he/she has exhibited in the show ring within the previous 12 months.
- An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom she or he has produced a pony within the previous 12 months (An exhibitor is the owner, the lessee or the person who produces and/or shows the pony).
- The Centre reserves the right to refuse any entry. Entries must include the correct fees. No substitution or nomination entries will be accepted.
- Entries will only be refunded when accompanied by a valid signed veterinary report.
- Objections shall be made in writing within 30 minutes of the event concerned and lodged with the Secretary together with the sum of £50, which shall be refunded if the objection is upheld.

Health and Safety

- The Centre has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards.
- Dogs must be kept on a lead AT ALL TIMES. Please clean up after your dog.
- In the interest of safety, adults must give due consideration to children whilst riding in collecting rings and warm up areas.
- The number of horses working in the collecting ring may be limited by number and/or to entrants in the next class only.
- Beaglers, Top Hats and Bowlers may only be worn if a signed Disclaimer has been returned to the Secretary
- Competitors under 16yrs of age MUST wear an appropriate strapped hat to improve safety standards.
- Stallions and colts must be sufficiently restrained at all times and handled by a competent person over 14 years. Competitors may be asked to leave the showground if the Organisers consider a stallion or colt to be insufficiently controlled.
- All animals must be sound. If, in the opinion of the judge an animal is considered to be unsound, the exhibitor will be asked to withdraw from the class. The judge's decision is final.
- Any animal found to be suffering from a contagious or infectious disease will be asked to leave the showground immediately.

- Any competitor, rider, groom or handler who acts in an abusive or aggressive manner towards any animal, spectator, official, volunteer or member of Ingliston staff will forfeit all entries and/or prize money and will be asked to leave the showground.
